Comments: These results were received October 31, 2005, and are an upgrade from DNAPrint ver 2.0 reported May 7 2003. Ver 2.0 results were 91% IE,9% EA, 0% NA,0% SSAF. Ver 2.5 results show 85% IE,9% EA, 6% NA,0% SSAF. Expected results 81% IE,0% EA,19% NA,0% SSAF The 6% NA surprisingly was deducted from the IE results in the ver 2.0 test, and the EA component remained the same (9%). I still have no indication of EA in my ancestry. The Euro 1.0 resultts were reported as 48% Northern European, 24% Middle Eastern, 18% Southeastern European, and 10% South Asian. My Y Haplogroup was estimated as R1B, and my mtDNA is U2. There is a family history of NA ancestry on both, the paternal and maternal sides. I have recently found that my maternal line traces back to Hancock Co., TN and a probable Melungeon heritage, through the surname of Wallen.

Comments: These are the results of my paternal Grandmother's DNA sample. (My results are below under Guest "SL"). The test indicating IE affiliation was almost identical to the expected results. However, I was expecting that the test would show up around 50% NA. Interesting that the test should come up 25% NA and 21% EA, instead of 50% NA (25% added to 21% is 46%, which is close to 50%). My paternal Grandmother is of known half Spanish and Portuguese and half Native American (Pueblo Tribes), and we have paper documentation of this side of my family going back to the 1700s. It is highly unlikely that she is of East Asian descent. The 21% EA is most likely Native American, based on the low genetic distance between Native Americans and East Asians (as published on the AncestrybyDNA website). It also says on the website that there were

later waves of migrations from Asia to the Americas, which might show up on the test as "East Asian", but is really a later migratory wave, like the Na-Dene peoples such as the Navajo and Apache. It's possible that the 21% East Asian in my Grandmother could be evidence of Navajo or Apache admixture with the Pueblo. Also interesting, is that my test was consistent with the knowledge of my Grandmother being 50% Native American (my expected NA was 12.5% and I tested for 16%). Additionally, I do have known East Asian (Filipino) descent from my paternal and maternal Grandfathers, NOT from my paternal and maternal Grandmothers. It could be that my results were more 'accurate' because I have both recent East Asian AND Native American ancestry, and the test was better able to distinguish between the two. If my paternal Grandmother is really 25% NA and 21% EA instead of 50% NA, it would make sense that my DNA test would show up with less NA and more EA, which it did not. The test is apparently confusing NA with EA and vice versa. It seems very common, judging by the numerous other posts on this website by people who have known Native American descent, but come up with East Asian results. My maternal grandfather was born in London, with roots exclusively in the Northern and Central Midlands of England. My maternal grandmother was descended from New England Puritans from East Anglia, New Jersey Dutchmen, Penn Dutch, and Delaware Valley Swedes. Hence, I was

surprised by my DNAPrint 2.0 results, which suggested that I was 89 percent Indo-European, and 11 percent East Asian. I never seriously believed I was descended from actual "East Asians" - most less from Native Americans - and assumed that this Asiatic 11 percent was of ancient Central Asian origin - perhaps Finno-Ugrian - that had found its way into both European and East Asian populations thousands of years ago. When I took DNAPrint 2.5, my Indo-European ancestry was corrected to 100 percent, which I would have expected the first time around. I took the Euro-DNA 1.0 test to see how "white bread" I really was, expecting about 90 percent "Northern European". Instead, the test pegged me as only 62 percent "Northern European" - 20 to 25 percent less than for the "average" Northern European or Irishman, according to AncestryByDNA's charts. I was also 22 percent Southeastern European, and 16 percent Middle Eastern. This does not come as a total surprise. My "trueborn English" grandfather had curly black hair, an aquiline nose, olive skin, and a short, wiry build, while my Irish grandfather - according to the only photo I have of him - could have walked the streets of Kabul without attracting attention. My Y-DNA haplotype, although R1b, has a DYS393 value of 12, which is more typical of R1b in Anatolia, Syria, Armenia, Macedonia and other such places, than of R1b in the British Isles. I had recently begun to think that this geographical resemblance was simply an accident, an illusion created by a single 1 step mutation. Now, considering that 38 percent of my DNA appears to come from that same general area, it no longer seems infeasible that my Y-DNA could, too. Also, considering that 90 percent of my "known" ancestry lies in England and Southern Scotland, my relatively high percentages of Southeastern European and Middle Eastern DNA lend credence to my contention that the Anglo-Scottish Border folk (the Border Reivers, to wit) are at least partly descended from Roman troops and settlers, many of whom came from the Mediterranean and the Middle East, and who manned Hadrian's Wall and the fortresses of North Britain at a time when that region was conspicuously underpopulated.
