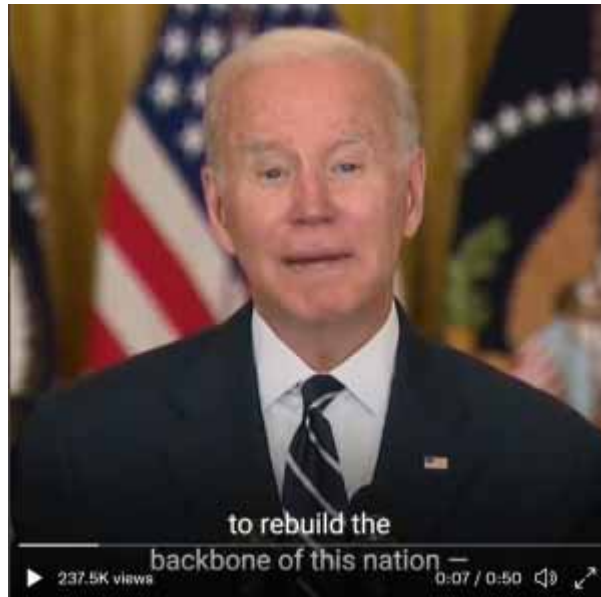
I am now announcing my immediate resignation!
