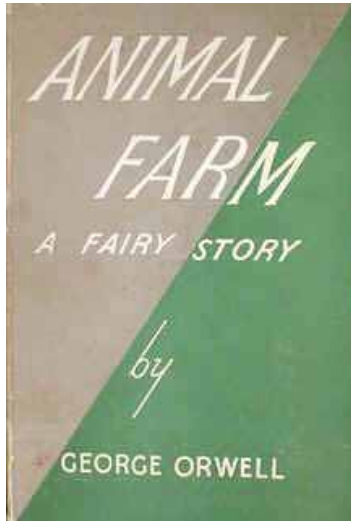


Heil Hypocrisy
