The original quote comes from a Nov. 13, 1787 letter Jefferson wrote to William Stevens Smith, John Adams’ son-in-law. The letter addressed [Shays’ Rebellion](#) in Massachusetts and Jefferson’s reaction to it in the larger context of the new Republic being formed in Philadelphia. The rebellion involved the State of Massachusetts’ efforts to collect on debts incurred by farmers for credits extended during the Revolutionary War and underscored the tensions between the farmers and an oppressive governmental exercise of power.

The full quote, in the context of the letter, reads thusly: “And what country can preserve it’s [sic] liberties *if their rulers are not warned from time to time that **their people preserve the spirit of resistance? Let them take arms.*** The remedy is to set them right as to facts, pardon and pacify them. What signify a few lives lost in a century or two? The tree of liberty must be refreshed from time to time with the blood of patriots *and tyrants.* *It is it’s [sic] natural manure.”* (Emphasis added)
