

# Senators Manchin and Sinema and the Cannibals of the Left

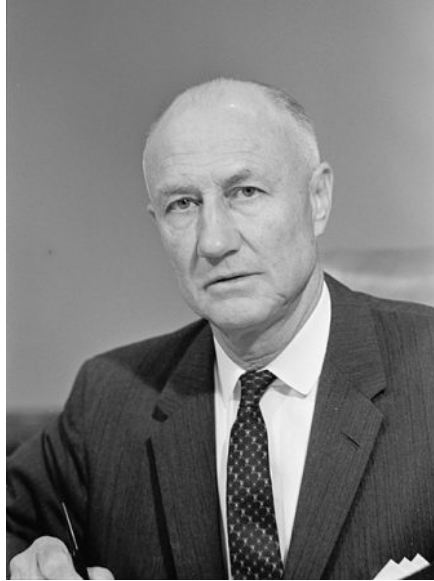
