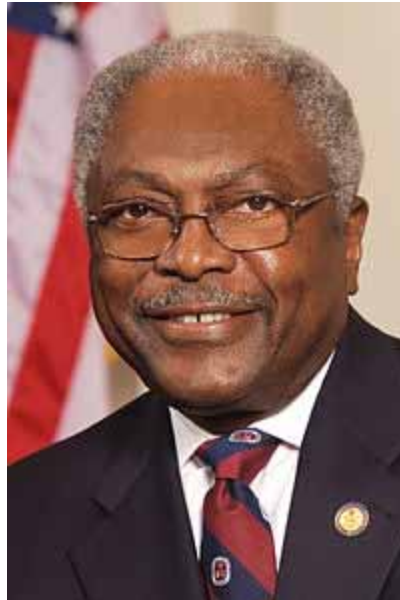


# The Clyburn Confession

(Apr. 3, 2021) -- This issue was addressed recently by your humble servant, but in the context of race-baiter Al Sharpton's threat against both Senator Manchin as well as Senator Kyrsten Sinema (D.
