

The Uber-Goof And His Pogrom Against America

Article II, Section 4:

The President, Vice President and all civil Officers of the United States, shall be removed from Office on Impeachment for, and Conviction of, Treason, Bribery, or other high Crimes and Misdemeanors.

The Constitution gives Congress the authority to impeach and remove the President,¹ Vice President, and all federal “civil officers” for treason, bribery, or other high crimes and misdemeanors.² This tool was inherited from English practice, in which Parliament impeached and convicted ministers and favorites of the Crown in a struggle to rein in the Crown’s power.

Recall that Brandon vowed that *zero* Americans would be left behind as he chaotically abandoned Afghanistan in perhaps the greatest “[high crime and misdemeanor](#)” since

enactment of the impeachments clause of the Constitution in 1787. And that doesn't even take into account the potential impeachments of members of his cabinet for lying, under oath, to Congress, also once known – when the rule of law mattered – as “perjury,” without consequence.
