The Kelsos, as a clue, came from the Strathclyde region of Scotland, near the Firth of Clyde and River Clyde. The earliest inhabitants of Strathclyde were probably the Britons. I don't have solid evidence, but my hypothesis is that the haplogroup I maternal ancestors of this line came very early to Britain, when it was first settled, and thus made up a part of the Britons, who were there before many others came. They spoke a language ancestral to Welsh. So far, the only very near match I have been in touch with is a Welsh man, so this seems like a good sign. I had no particular expectations, but I didn't want to be in H, and was hoping for an ancient and uncommon haplogroup, and that was what I found in haplogroup I. The only one I would have liked better would have been U. I'm the one running the Haplogroup I Home Page, and hope to hear from all members of this haplogroup, so your results can be compared with the others who have already participated. Thanks!
