

**Charles Kerchner** has been pursuing genealogy for over 30 years, authoring several tutorial and help papers on Pennsylvania German research. During the last six years, he has been a pioneer in the new field of genetic genealogy, launching one of the first dozen surname projects by a genealogist, the Kerchner Surname Project. In 2005, he helped launch the International Society of Genetic Genealogy (www.isogg.org) and serves as coordinator of the Mid-Atlantic section.
